- Support healthcare providers as they care for their communities

- Connect organizations in need with available resources through intentional collaboration
- Design and implement strategic projects

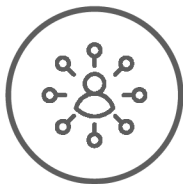

STRENGTHENING HEALTHCARE SYSTEM IN HAITI



The Haiti Health Network continued operating and leading with the goal of supporting healthcare providers through a season of unprecedented violence and increasing challenges. The Haiti Health Network continued its bi-monthly meetings and weekly clinical lectures throughout the unrest.

Our team organized and led **145** Haiti Health Network meetings and Connected over **1,400** healthcare leaders and providers

The Haiti Health Network has over 800 partners and this allows us to be a powerful voice for the voiceless. Our team spent countless hours advocating before members of congress, the UN, and State Department regarding the immense challenges facing healthcare providers in Haiti.

We conducted 3 largescale surveys of the Haitian healthcare community and commissioned a nationwide population survey to assess the need and desire for outside intervention. This survey was shared widely with government leaders and was published in The Miami Herald.



We never lose sight of our main goal:

Ensure access to quality healthcare for all in Haiti and support the healthcare heroes who fight every day to make sure patients receive care.



BIOMEDICAL TRAINING CENTER AND APPRENTICESHIP

Haiti Health Network healthcare programs emphasize local capacity building and sustainability. The establishment of a biomedical training center in Pignon, Haiti is one example of how we support the advancement of the biomedical profession in Haiti. Maintaining and repairing complex medical equipment is not easy and requires ongoing training year after year. The presence and operation of this training center provides ongoing training and support for biomedical professionals throughout Haiti and those interested in becoming trained technicians. Upcoming classes will include oxygen therapy, water purification systems, patient monitoring, and basic x-ray repair. **Rotary International** has been a key partner in making this training center a reality.



In addition to providing weeklong training programs and e-learning opportunities, we launched a biomedical apprenticeship program whereby junior technicians are shadowing senior biomedical professionals. This on-the-job training is priceless. These apprentices will begin their first solo work by taking detailed medical equipment inventories at our partner hospitals that are part of our medical equipment standardization program.





DISTRIBUTION PROJECTS

The Haiti Health Network team continued to efficiently and effectively deliver medications, supplies, and medical equipment to facilities in Haiti despite the unrest. We were able to:

- Ship over **200** Equipping the Caregivers Kits to a regional partner in Southern Haiti that will support over **70** rural clinics.
- Distribute **90** midwife kits to **33** facilities that will support **4500** live births.
- Distribute vitamins and deworming medication to **116** facilities that will impact over **115,000** women and children.
- Deliver and install over **100** pieces of medical equipment to **25** hospitals.

MEDICAL EQUIPMENT MODERNIZATION AND STANDARDIZATION



We continue to standardize medical equipment throughout Haiti and work with partners to provide additional training and preventative maintenance. In addition, Haiti Health Network will benefit from a grant from **USAID's ASHA (American Schools and Hospitals Abroad)** program that will allow us to expand equipment modernization and standardization into 12 additional hospitals in Northern Haiti. HHN continues to work closely with the Ministry of Health and will procure and deliver over 500 pieces of medical equipment to improve the quality of care given at each of these facilities.

OXYGEN DELIVERY IN HAITI

Providing medical grade oxygen to critically ill patients is vital for quality healthcare delivery. We all learned with COVID just how important this is and how quickly lives can be lost without it. The nation of Haiti was gifted with 18 Oxygen generation plants during the pandemic from 3 different manufacturers located in China, the US, and Portugal. The Haiti Health Network partnered with **The Dalton Foundation** and **FHI360** on the **EpiC-USAID** project to help install and maintain these units. This is a complex and challenging project, yet the team made significant progress on sustaining oxygen delivery throughout Haiti which impacted over **13,000** lives.
